

Looking back and looking forward | Tasks for participants

Short description	Participants reflect on what they have learned in Module 3 and focus on preparing for the next steps in the learning process. For this, they complete the tasks in their personal digital diaries and in this way gradually develop (after completing each module) their own documentation for the project lessons. As they work on this, their main focus is on the way what they have learned relates to them personally and on forming their own thoughts and opinions on the subject matter.

Instructions	<p><i>Tip 1:</i> If there is no more time in the project lesson for the next stage in composing the 'Letter to myself' (Activity 1.5), this may still be assigned as an additional homework task.</p> <p><i>Tip 2:</i> With regard to the recommended form, and where and how the tasks for the personal diary should be performed, reference is made to instruction sheet 1.6.</p> <p>Personal diary tasks:</p> <p>Formulate a response on the following two questions under 'MODULE 3':</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Humanitarian Principles in practice • The Humanitarian Principles – opportunities and challenges <p><i>Additional task for the upcoming project lesson (Module 4):</i></p> <p>Activity 3.4 (discussions in pairs on finding a common vision) and Activity 3.5 (reflecting on the story of a dilemma) have already prepared students for thinking about the issues to be dealt with in the last two modules. At the beginning of the fourth module, participants will be asked to commence the process of gradually forming their own opinions (Activities 4.1 & 4.2), which will be crucial to the activities that follow.
